DAY 01: ARRIVAL - TOKYO (JAPAN)

- ▶ Welcome to **Tokyo (Japan)**! Upon arrival, clear the immigration formalities.
- ▶ **You will be picked up from the Airport and dropped at the hotel.**
- ▶ **Meet & Greet our Tour Manager at Hotel Lobby area.**
- ▶ Later, check-in Hotel (standard check-in time is 15:00 hours).
- ▶ Rest of the day is at leisure.

DAY 02: FULL DAY TOKYO - TOKYO SKY TREE - 3D TEAM LAB

- ▶ Today after breakfast, head for **Tokyo City Tour**:
 - We will see **UENO PARK**: The home of a number of major museums, Ueno Park is also celebrated in spring for its Cherry blossoms and Hanami. It is also home to Ueno Zoo, Japan's first zoological garden, **IMPERIAL PALACE (Outside View)**, **ASAKUSA TEMPLE**, **NAKAMISE SHOPPING STREET**
- ▶ Later proceed for **TOKYO SKY TREE**
 - The highest observation Tower in Japan
- ▶ Later proceed to visit **ODAIBA - STATUE OF LIBERTY**, and Photo Stop at **RAINBOW BRIDGE**.
- ▶ Next you visit **3D TEAM LAB TOYOSU**
 - TeamLab Planets are digital art museums in Tokyo. They're unique, immersive experiences with projection mapping, music, lights and effects

DAY 03: FULL DAY TOKYO TOUR - SUMIDA RIVER CRUISE

- ▶ Today morning, after breakfast proceed for **FULL DAY TOKYO TOUR**.
- ▶ We will start our tour with:
- ▶ **MEIJI SHRINE**: Meiji Shrine is a shrine located in Shibuya Ward, Tokyo. The deities enshrined here are Emperor Meiji, the 122nd emperor, and Empress Shoken.
- ▶ Later we will take Photo Stop at **OLYMPIC STADIUM**



- ▶ Post lunch we will proceed for **GOVERNMENT BUILDING OBSERVATORY**: The Tokyo



Metropolitan Government Building, is the seat of the Tokyo Metropolitan Government, which governs the special wards, cities, towns, and villages that constitute the Tokyo Metropolis. Located in Shinjuku ward, the building was designed by architect Kenzo Tange.

- ▶ **SHIBUYA CROSSING**: Shibuya Crossing is the world's busiest pedestrian crossing,

with as many as 3,000 people crossing at a time. **Hachiko Statue (Photo Stop)**

- ▶ Later proceed for **SUMIDA RIVER CRUISE**: You'll experience a totally different view of the city from the river and you'll be reminded that Tokyo is indeed a port city
- ▶ Then spend **free time for Shopping at GINZA**.
- ▶ Post tour return to the hotel.

DAY 04: HAKONE - MT FUJI - HAKONE ROPEWAY - LAKE ASHI CRUISE

- ▶ After breakfast, Check out and proceed to experience **MT. FUJI** - World's Iconic Volcanic Eruption. Take in the amazing views from Mt. Fuji 5th Station (**Weather Permitting**)
- ▶ Then visit **HAKONE ROPEWAY**, it connects Sounzan Station with Togendai Station and stops at Owakudani and Ubako stations on the way.
- ▶ Later proceed for **LAKE ASHI TO HAKONE- EN GARDEN**.
- ▶ Post tour check in at hotel

DAY 05: NAGOYA - TOTOTA MUSEUM – SC MAGLEV AND RAILWAY PARK

- ▶ After breakfast, Check out and proceed for **NAGOYA**.
- ▶ Upon Arrival, proceed for **TOYOTA COMMEMORATIVE MUSEUM OF INDUSTRY AND TECHNOLOGY**
 - Witness motorized tram tour through the Weld and Assembly shops of the



Cambridge Plant to see how Team Members and robots build Toyota and Lexus vehicles.

- ▶ Later proceed for **SC MAGLEV AND RAILWAY PARK**

- The Scmaglev And Railway Park Is A Railway Museum Owned By Central Japan Railway Company In Nagoya, Japan. The Museum Features 39 Full-Size Railway Vehicles And One Bus Exhibit, Train Cab Simulators, And Railway Model Dioramas

- ▶ Post Tour Check in at Hotel

DAY 06: NAGOYA – HIROSHIMA (BY BULLET TRAIN) – ATOMIC BOMB MUSEUM

- ▶ **01 Big Size Luggage will courier to Kyoto Hotel & Prepared 01 Night Hand baggage for Hiroshima Hotel.**
- ▶ After breakfast check out & transfer to Nagoya Station to board **BULLET TRAIN** for Hiroshima,
- ▶ Upon arrival, visit **HIROSHIMA PEACE PARK:**
 - It is dedicated to the legacy of Hiroshima as the first city in the world to suffer a nuclear attack at the end of World War II, and to the memories of the bomb's direct and indirect victims.
- ▶ Later, visit **ATOMIC BOMB DOME:**



- The Hiroshima Peace Memorial, originally the Hiroshima Prefectural Industrial Promotion Hall, and now commonly called the Genbaku Dome, Atomic Bomb Dome or A-Bomb Dome, is part of the Hiroshima Peace Memorial Park in Hiroshima, Japan and was designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1996.

- ▶ Post tour, check in at hotel in Hiroshima

DAY 07: HIROSHIMA – MIYAJIMA ISLAND - KYOTO

- ▶ Today after breakfast, Check out and proceed to **MIYAJIMA ISLAND** by road.
 - First stop is at **ITSUKUSHIMA SHRINE**: It is a Shinto shrine on the island of Itsukushima, best known for its "Floating" Torii Gate.
 - Miyajima Island has long been a holy site in Shinto, and Itsukushima Shrine was built in the 12th century, the shrine, and the torii gate, are built over water.



- ▶ Later proceed for Kyoto.
- ▶ Upon Arrival check in at hotel.

DAY 08: FULL DAY KYOTO TOUR

- ▶ Today after breakfast, Proceed for Kyoto Sightseeing's
- ▶ **KINKAKUJI TEMPLE** is a Zen temple in northern Kyoto whose top two floors are completely covered in gold leaf
- ▶ Later, we visit **RYŌAN-JI**: It is a Zen temple located in northwest Kyoto, Japan

- ▶ Then we visit, **MARUYAMA PARK** (Cherry Blossom Spot)



- ▶ Later we proceed for **FUSHIMI INARI SHRINE**: The shrine sits at the base of a mountain also named Inari which is 233 metres (764 ft) above sea level, and includes trails up the mountain to many smaller shrines which span 4 kilometres (2.5 mi) and take approximately 2 hours to walk up.
- ▶ Post tour return back at hotel

DAY 09: KYOTO – KIYOMIZUDERA TEMPLE – TODAIJI TEMPLE – NARA DEER PARK – OSAKA

- ▶ Today after breakfast, Check out and Proceed for **KIYOMIZUDERA TEMPLE**



- Situated atop a small mountain on the east side of Kyoto, Kiyomizudera Temple offers a commanding view of the city. The temple's stage, supported by massive pillars, is one of the most famous images of Japan.

- ▶ Later Drive by **GION CORNER** and proceed to **NARA DEER PARK** and visit **TODAIJI TEMPLE** - an incredible scale of size, stretching approximately 57 meters wide, 50

meters deep, and 48 meters tall, making it famous for being among the largest wooden buildings in the world.

- ▶ Later free time at **NARAMACHI DISTRICT.**
- ▶ Then transfer to the hotel and check in

DAY 10: OSAKA – AKASHI KAIKYO BRIDGE - OSAKA CASTLE – UMEDA SKY TOWER

- ▶ Today after breakfast, Proceed for **KOBE AND OSAKA SIGHTSEEINGS**

- ▶ Proceed for **AKASHI KAIKYO BRIDGE**

- At almost four kilometers in length, the Akashi Kaikyo Bridge is the world's longest suspension bridge. The bridge links the city of Kobe with Awaji Island



- ▶ Post kobe tour proceed for **OSAKA CASTLE** - The castle is one of Japan's most famous landmarks and it played a major role in the unification



of Japan during the sixteenth century of the Azuchi-Momoyama period.

- ▶ Then we proceed for visit to **UMEDA SKY TOWER** - The Umeda Sky Building is the nineteenth-tallest building in Osaka Prefecture, Japan, and one of the city's most recognizable landmarks. It consists of two 40-story towers that connect at their two uppermost stories, with bridges and an escalator crossing the wide atrium-like space in the center.

- ▶ Evening is free for shopping at

- ▶ Return to Seoul, upon arrival we will visit **Dongdaemun Plaza (DDP) & Dongdaemun (Shopping area).**
- ▶ Return to hotel.
