DAY 01: ARRIVAL - TOKYO (JAPAN)

DAY 02: TOKYO CITY TOUR



- ▶ Breakfast at hotel. Later, Proceed for Full Day **Tokyo Sightseeing Tour:**
- ▶ Visit, **UENO PARK** (Cherry Blossom Spot), **IMPERIAL PALACE** (Outside View).
- ▶ Proceed to **ASAKUSA TEMPLE:** Also known as Sensō-ji (Shrine of the Three gods), it is one of the most famous Shinto shrines in the city. The shrine honors the three men who founded the neighboring Sensō-ji.
- ▶ Followed by **NAKAMISE SHOPPING STREET**
- ▶ Later Proceed for **TOKYO SKY TREE** - an iconic landmark that offers breathtaking views of Tokyo from its observation decks 350 M.
- ▶ After Lunch Proceed to **ODAIBA:**
- ▶ **RAINBOW BRIDGE** (Drive by)
- ▶ **STATUE OF LIBERTY - ODAIBA**
- ▶ Later Visit, **SHIBUYA CROSSING:** which is the world's busiest pedestrian crossing, with as many as 3,000 people crossing at a time.
- ▶ **HACHIKO STATUE** (Photo Stop): which is a bronze sculpture of the Akita dog Hachiko, located outside Shibuya Station in Tokyo, Japan. Hachiko continued to wait for his owner at the station every day for nine years after his owner's death.

DAY 03: TOKYO CITY TOUR

- ▶ Breakfast at hotel
- ▶ Proceed for **FULL DAY TOKYO TOUR.**
- ▶ **MEIJI SHRINE:** The shrine's daily ceremonies, incredible architecture, and scenic grounds make it a memorable and rejuvenating destination for tourists and Shinto practitioners alike.
- ▶ **OLYMPIC STADIUM** (Drive by)
- ▶ **3D TEAM LAB TOYOSU:** is a digital art museum where you walk through water, and a garden where you become one with the flowers. They're unique, immersive experiences with projection mapping, music, lights and effects.
- ▶ Later proceed to **GINZA SHOPPING STREET:** shopping district, known for its luxury and prestige. It's home to flagship stores of global brands, Japanese designer boutiques, and high-end department stores.

▶ **OWAKUDANI VALLEY** (Photo Stop)

▶ **HAKONE ROPEWAY** - The Hakone Ropeway offers a scenic route connecting Owakudani valley to Togendai on Lake Ashi, with stops at Ubako and Ubako stations.

▶ **LAKE ASHI CRUISE** (Togendai -

DAY 05: TOKYO - HIROSHIMA (BY BULLET TRAIN)

- ▶ After breakfast, check-out from the hotel and proceed to the Train Station for Bullet Train to Hiroshima.
- ▶ After Arrive at **Hiroshima**.
- ▶ Visit **ATOMIC BOMB DOME** : The Bomb Detonated Almost Directly Above The Building, And The Downward Force Of The Explosion Left The Structure's Framework Intact. Today, The Atomic Bomb Dome Is A Unesco World Heritage Site.
- ▶ In same route, Visit **HIROSHIMA PEACE MEMORIAL PARK**: dedicated to the legacy of Hiroshima as the first city in the world to suffer a nuclear attack at the end of World War II.
- ▶ After that, visit **THE HIROSHIMA PEACE MEMORIAL MUSEUM** collects and displays belongings left by the victims, photos, and other materials that convey the horror of that event.
- ▶ After that, Visit **HIROSHIMA CASTLE** - was built at the end of the 16th century. The





castle tower, which remained until before World War II, was once destroyed by the atomic bomb, but the castle was reconstructed to its former appearance and is loved by local residents as a symbol of Hiroshima.

- ▶ Later, proceed to check in to hotel. *(Standard check-in time 15.00. Early check in subject to availability with surcharge).*

DAY 06: HIROSHIMA – MIYAJIMA ISLAND

- ▶ Breakfast at the hotel
- ▶ Proceed to **MIYAJIMA ISLAND** is a small island, It is most famous for its giant torii gate, which at high tide seems to float on the water.
- ▶ **ITSUKUSHIMA SHRINE:** It is a Shinto shrine on the island of Itsukushima, best known for its "Floating" Torii Gate. the Torii Gate was to protect those around it from evil spirits.

DAY 07: HIROSHIMA – OSAKA



- ▶ After breakfast, check-out from the hotel and proceed to the Osaka.

▶ After Arrived at Osaka, Visit **OSAKA CASTLE** - a Japanese castle in Chūō-ku, Osaka, Japan. The castle is one of Japan's most famous landmarks and played a major role in the unification of Japan during the sixteenth century of the Azuchi–Momoyama period.

- ▶ Later, proceed to check in to hotel. *(Standard check-in time 15.00. Early check in subject to availability with surcharge).*

DAY 08: OSAKA – ARASHIYAMA BAMBOO FOREST – TEMPLE TOUR

- ▶ Breakfast at the hotel
- ▶ Proceed for the **ARASHIYAMA BAMBOO FOREST** - Officially called the Sagano Bamboo Forest, this enchanting spot features a 500-meter path surrounded by towering bamboo stalks.
- ▶ Later Visit, **KINKAKU-JI (GOLDEN TEMPLE)** - officially named Rokuon-ji, is a Zen Buddhist temple in Kyoto, Japan and a tourist attraction. It is designated as a World Heritage Site.
- ▶ Later visit, beautiful **FUSHIMI INARI SHRINE** - The ultimate torii gate experience. Fushimi Inari is the most important of several thousands of shrines dedicated to Inari, the Shinto god of rice. Foxes are thought to be Inari's messengers, resulting in many fox statues across the shrine grounds.

DAY 09: OSAKA – NARA – KOBE – OSAKA



- ▶ Breakfast at the hotel
- ▶ Proceed to **NARA DEER PARK** Nara Park is a public park located in the city of Nara, Japan.
- ▶ In route visit **TODAJI TEMPLE** - a Buddhist temple & an incredible scale of size, stretching approximately 57 meters wide, 50 meters deep, and 48 meters tall, making & World Heritage Site that houses Japan's largest statue of Buddha
- ▶ Later proceed to **KOBE EARTHQUAKE MEMORIAL MUSEUM**- On January 17, 1995 at 5:46 am, the city of Kobe was hit by the Great Hanshin Awaji Earthquake, resulting in the death of more than 5000 people and the destruction of tens of thousands of homes. The Earthquake Memorial Museum, part of the Disaster Reduction and Human Renovation Institution.
- ▶ After Museum, Visit One Way **CABLE CAR - MOUNT ROKKO**.
