DAY 01: ARRIVAL – EDINBURGH

DAY 02: EDINBURGH – GUIDED CITY TOUR - EDINBURGH CASTLE



- ▶ After breakfast, proceed for **Edinburgh CITY TOUR**.
 - Explore the city's history and landmarks, such as the Royal Mile, and , Princes Street
 - ▶ Enjoy local legends, folklore, and "hidden secrets" of the Old Town.
 - Later, visit **Edinburgh castle**
 - A historic fortress on an extinct volcano in Scotland's capital, serving as a former royal residence and an active military base
 - Return to the hotel & rest

DAY 03: EDINBURGH – STIRLING CASTLE - URQUHART CASTLE - INVERNESS (APPROX. 251 KMS/3.3 HOURS)

- ▶ After breakfast at the hotel, Check out from the hotel and drive to Inverness.
- ▶ En-route, visit to STIRLING CASTLE.
 - **STIRLING CASTLE:** one of Scotland's greatest stone castles – an icon integral to how we understand the nation's story.
- ▶ Later proceed for Inverness by road. Enjoy scenic journey to Inverness.
- ▶ Upon Arrival, Visit to **URQUHART CASTLE**
- ▶ Check in to Hotel & Rest

 - ▶ Proceed to **INVERNESS GUIDED CITY TOUR.**
 - Different interests and durations, covering landmarks like Portree, Kilt Rock, Quarry, Eilean Donan Castle etc.

DAY 05: INVERNESS – LOCHNESS – FORT WILLIAM - GLASGOW (APPROX. 169 KMS/ 4 HOURS)

- ▶ After breakfast, Checkout from the hotel, Drive to Loch Ness. En-route enjoy scenic journey of highlands.
- ▶ Upon arrival, In Loch Ness enjoy 1 hour **Cruise** - Cruise across Loch Ness, the largest body of fresh water in Great Britain, and admire the surrounding mountainous landscape.
- ▶ Further, explore the Scenic View & Photo Stop at Fort William.
- ▶ Continue your journey to Glasgow.
- ▶ Upon Arrival, Check in to the hotel & Rest.

▶ Later, Proceed to Cairnryan Port to take ferry and transfer to Belfast.

▶ **Welcome to Belfast (Ireland)!** Upon arrival, proceed to your hotel & check in.

DAY 07: BELFAST - GUIDED CITY TOUR - GIANT'S CAUSEWAY

▶ After breakfast, Proceed to **GUIDED CITY TOUR** – Visit Belfast Castle, St. Anne's Cathedral

▪ **BELFAST CASTLE:** Belfast Castle is a mansion located in Cave Hill Country Park in Belfast, Northern Ireland, in a prominent position 400 feet above sea level.

▪ **ST. ANNE'S CATHEDRAL:** a landmark Romanesque-style Anglican cathedral in Belfast's Cathedral Quarter.

▶ Later, Proceed to **Giants Causeway** - Visit the caves King Joffrey

▶ Evening back to hotel.

DAY 08: BELFAST - DUBLIN (APPROX. 169 KMS/ 2.5 HOURS)

- ▶ After Breakfast, Check out from the hotel, transfer towards Dublin
- ▶ Upon Arrival, Proceed to **GUIDED TOUR OF DUBLIN**: Explore historic sites such as Trinity College, Dublin Castle, and St. Patrick's Cathedral.
- ▶ Later, visit **Bram Stoker's house, Phoenix Park**: The Phoenix Park is one of the largest enclosed public parks in any capital city in Europe. It was originally formed as a royal hunting Park in the 1660s and opened to the public in 1747
- ▶ Post Tour, proceed to the hotel & Check in.

DAY 09: DUBLIN - CLIFF OF MOHER - THE ARAN ISLANDS & THE MAUM TURK MOUNTAINS

- ▶ After breakfast, transfer to **CLIFF OF MOHER**:
 - The most famous cliffs in Ireland, will leave you awestruck, creating memories that will stay with you forever. The Cliffs of Moher host major colonies of nesting sea birds and are one of the country's most important bird-breeding sites
- ▶ Further, Proceed to **THE ARAN ISLANDS & THE MAUM TURK MOUNTAINS** by ferry.
 - The Aran Islands and the Maumturk Mountains are two distinct, but nearby, natural attractions in western Ireland. The Aran Islands are a group of three islands in Galway Bay, known for ancient forts and traditional Aran sweaters, and are accessible by ferry.
- ▶ Return to destined hotel & rest

DAY 10: DUBLIN - WICKLOW – ORIENTATION TOUR OF WICKLOW – GLENDALOUGH - DUBLIN

▶ After breakfast, transfer to **WICKLOW**:

- Enjoy scenic natural beauty of Wicklow & Glendalough
- Upon Arrival, Proceed to **ORIENTATION TOUR OF WICKLOW** : Known as the "Garden of Ireland", Wicklow was historically the county with the highest percentage of woodlands



▶ Later, **Enjoy sandy shores of beach**:

Wicklow's sandy beaches are mainly represented by the Brittas Bay area, known for its long, 5 km stretch of golden, powdery sand and high dunes. This Blue Flag beach is a popular destination for swimming, walking, and water sports, with a designated area of ecological significance due to its unique flora and fauna.

▶ Further, Transfer to Glendalough, explore at **Glendalough Lake & mountains**.

- A stunning glacial valley in the Wicklow Mountains, famous for its two deep, moody lakes—the Upper and Lower Lakes—and a rich 6th-century monastic settlement

▶ Return to the destined hotel & rest.
