DAY 01: ARRIVAL – HANOI – HALF DAY CITY TOUR

- ▶ **Welcome to Vietnam!**
- ▶ Upon arrival, clear the immigration formalities and proceed to **HANOI CITY TOUR**.
- ▶ We will start with a coffee shop near Train-street. *(drinks own arrangement)*
- ▶ Hanoi has always been a symbol of culture and a source of pride throughout the history, bustling Hanoi offers a charming blend of new and old.
- ▶ Visit **BA DINH SQUARE** – the biggest square in Hanoi where all the biggest cultural, political events of the cities, especially demonstrations, take place.
- ▶ **VIETNAM ETHNOLOGY MUSEUM HANOI** offers an insight into the 54 different ethnic groups of Vietnam in an effort to preserve cultural heritage and promote sociology-cultural diversity within the country. *(This closed by Monday will be changed by another site)*
- ▶ Later, proceed to check in to hotel. *(Standard check-in time 15.00. Early check in subject to availability with surcharge).*

DAY 02: HANOI – NINH BINH DAY TOUR

- ▶ After breakfast, depart for **NINH BINH**. Which owns Hoa Lu and Tam Coc as the most favorite sightseeing of tourists from all over the world.
- ▶ After 2 hours, you will arrive at Hoa Lu Ancient Capital. In 1010, Hoa Lu became the old citadel. In Hoa Lu there are now 2 temples have been built on the ground of the old royal palace, one is dedicated to King Dinh Tien Hoang, the other is to King Le Dai Hanh.





- ▶ Afternoon, 05 minute-walk to the boat station and start the 02 hour-boat trip to visit Tam Coc. Known as “Halong Bay on land”, Tam Coc are three limestone caves stretching along Ngo Dong River.
- ▶ The boat trip is a nice journey along the river with peaceful scenery of Limestone Mountains, rice paddy and the site of some temples along the way from Hang Ca (first cave) to Hang Hai (second cave) and Hang Ba (third cave).

DAY 03: HANOI – HA LONG BAY CRUISE

- ▶ After breakfast, check out from the hotel and transfer for **HALONG BAY CRUISE**.
- ▶ Ha long Bay has twice been recognized by UNESCO as a World Natural Heritage Area for its exceptional scenic beauty and one of the world’s greatest natural wonders.
- ▶ Arrive in Halong and board a traditional sailing junk. As the vessel sets sails, you will be greeted by the Crew Team who will aim throughout your stay at providing you with the highest standards of service for a pure pleasure and utmost comfort onboard.
- ▶ While onboard, you can take advantage at leisure of the cruise services; surrounded by a stunning setting in motion, you could attend our chef’s cooking demonstration and try your skills in the art of traditional Vietnamese cooking.
- ▶ Defined to be one of the highlights of your stay, a highly refined, innovative and varied cuisine will be presented for Lunch and Dinner in the elegant dining-room, accompanied by a wide selection of wines and beverages (*with extra charge applied for drink*).
- ▶ In the evening enjoy the entertainment activities as movie night, squid fishing or just enjoying a cocktail surrounded by limestone rocks majestically springing out from silent waters in the night.

DAY 04: HALONG BAY – HANOI

- ▶ Start the day enjoying some delights with a light breakfast and follow by a colorful brunch.
- ▶ Early birds can attend a **TAI CHI** demonstration on the sundeck at the break of dawn.
- ▶ Continue exploring Halong Bay sailing across its 2000 islets and visiting some of its major highlights.
- ▶ After tour, transfer back to Hanoi.
- ▶ We then take a green car or **CYLCO TOUR** (group small than 5) around the Old Quarter of Hanoi, a fascinating network of narrow alleys and shop houses also known as **‘THE 36 STREETS’** – each street being named after the merchandise traditionally sold there, ranging from fabrics, medicines to crafts.
- ▶ In the Evening, enjoy **WATER PUPPET SHOW**.
- ▶ Later, check in to the Hanoi hotel and spend the rest day for leisure.

DAY 05: HANOI – DANANG

- ▶ After breakfast, check-out from the hotel and proceed to the airport for flight to Danang.
- ▶ Arriving at Danang Airport, you'll be welcomed and picked up by our guide, then be transferred you to hotel.
- ▶ Later, proceed to check in to hotel. *(Standard check-in time 15.00. Early check in subject to availability with surcharge).*

DAY 06: DANANG – FULL DAY BANA HILL – GOLDEN BRIDGE

- ▶ After breakfast, departure to **BA NA HILLS**, pass the sea-shore on Nguyen Tat Thanh Street, one of the most beautiful roads of Da Nang City and Red Beach, where the French first landed in Da Nang.
- ▶ Arrive at the Cable car station at the foot of **BA NA MOUNTAIN**. Enjoy the first leg Cable car, which achieves two Guinness World Records in 2009, longest non-stop cable car (5,042m) and highest non-stop cable car (1,292m).
- ▶ First, step on **GOLDEN BRIDGE** which stands 1,400m above sea level in the Ba Na hills, is the latest tourist attraction in Da Nang and has attracted hordes of guests since it opened.
- ▶ Visit the Le Jardin, old wineries, remains of French Villas and Ling Ung Pagoda with 27m high Buddha status.
- ▶ We then leave the Le Jardin for the second cable car station to visit the top of mountain and see the remains of old villas. Conquer the Peak of Chua Mountain at the height of 1,487m.
- ▶ View the whole Da Nang city under the cluster of white clouds. Leave Peak of Chua Mountain, visit the trail of Dreaming Stream, Rainbow Waterfall, Suspension Bridge, Golden Valley, and ruined Opera House.
- ▶ Play with wild monkeys and take photos, freely then we return to Cable car station at foot of Ba Na Mountain then transfer to Danang.

DAY 07: DANANG – HALF DAY CITY TOUR

- ▶ After breakfast, Proceed for **HALF DAY CITY TOUR**.
- ▶ Start our city tour visiting the **04 famous bridges of the city**:
- ▶ **Han River Bridge** - Constructed in 1997, the Han River Bridge was the first swing bridge built by Vietnamese architects and workers. This makes it a symbol of the city's emergence and the vitality of Danang's people.
- ▶ **Tran Thi Ly Bridge** - The colors of the bridge's elegant pylon and deck change at night, creating an iconic, eye-catching landmark in the city every evening.
- ▶ **Dragon Bridge** - Showcasing the city's rise, the bridge is a significant landmark of Danang. Every weekend at 9:00pm, the dragon breathes fire and water, creating a fantastic photo opportunity.
- ▶ **Love Lock Bridge** - Hundreds of couples visit this bridge every day to leave the love locks that symbolize their lifelong togetherness and love bond. The bridge becomes enchanting at night when the thousands of heart-shaped red lanterns show their glitters in the water and make it sparkle.
- ▶ Continue transferring to visit Son Tra peninsula- the **biggest pagoda** in Central Vietnam and famous My Khe Beach. We keep visiting the Linh Ung Bai But pagoda with the tallest Lady Buddha statue in Vietnam.

DAY 08: DANANG – COCONUT VILLAGE TOUR – HOI AN

▶ After breakfast, transfer to **CAM THANH COCONUT VILLAGE**.



- ▶ Here, you will experience **BASKET BOAT RIDE** around the coconut forest, learn about the daily life of Vietnamese fishermen, their families and their community. During the trip, the boatman will take coconut leaves to make funny natural ornaments such as hats, rings, glasses ... extremely lovely for you.
- ▶ You will surely experience the feeling of floating on the waves of water and join a equally fun basket boat race between the baskets together in the cheering and bustling music drum.
- ▶ Continue to visit **HOIAN ANCIENT TOWN** – which are the famous 400 years old Japanese Bridge, 300 years old Chinese temple, 200 years old Vietnamese former merchants' house.

DAY 09: DANANG – FLY TO HO CHI MINH – HALF DAY CITY TOUR

- ▶ After breakfast, check-out from the hotel and proceed to the airport for flight to Ho chi minh city.




- ▶ Later, proceed to check in to hotel. *(Standard check-in time 15.00. Early check in subject to availability with surcharge).*
- ▶ Afternoon, learn about the city's historic landmarks as you tour the city with your guide. Visit the former **PRESIDENTIAL PALACE**, headquarters to the Saigon Government during the Vietnam-American war.
- ▶ By drive, see the **NOTRE DAME CATHEDRAL**, a red brick building with twin spires based on the original construction from Paris, then head across the square to the **CENTRAL POST OFFICE** designed by the French architect Gustav Eiffel.

DAY 10: SAIGON – CU CHI TUNNELS

- ▶ After breakfast, we will drive overland to **CU CHI TUNNELS** - are an immense network of interconnected tunnels near Saigon that are part of a much larger network lying below much of the country. A guided visit to these tunnels provides a better understanding of their history, the hardship of life underground and the resilience of the Vietnamese during combat.
- ▶ The tunnels were built and used initially by the Viet Cong guerrillas as hiding spots to protect them from the French air and ground sweeps. They later served as communication routes, storage facilities, hospitals and living quarters for the guerrilla fighters throughout the Vietnam-American war.
- ▶ You're invited to enter a section of the tunnels to witness the secrets of the tunnels firsthand. Your guide will also show you various mantraps employed from this period, the remains of an American tank and numerous B52 bomb craters. There is also the opportunity to fire an M60, M16 or AK47 rifle at the range next to the tunnel complex.
- ▶ End this day's tour at the central **BEN THANH MARKET**, where vendors display a vast array of goods and handicrafts, appealing to every taste.
- ▶ Then after, reach back to hotel.
